RESOLUTION #26-2024 ROAD VACATION PUBLIC HEARING

WHEREAS, the Clayton County Board of Supervisors desires that action be taken to vacate and close a section of a Clayton County Secondary Road, described as follows:

An Un-Named Road originally established June 1, 1891 (See Road Record Volume 3, page 577) lying in Section 18-19 of T-93N R-4W (Read Township) of Clayton County, Iowa.
