Information Technology Director Matt Sherman provided a departmental update.

The Board discussed potential obligations of American Rescue Plan Act and LATCF funds. Reimer moved, Doeppke seconded to de-obligate the following items for payment through American Rescue Plan Acts funds as they were funded through other sources: mobile command center vehicle (UNK \$), shelving units for Emergency Management building (UNK \$), and door openings (\$33,860.00), doors (\$11,088.11), and dumpster covering (\$13,485.00) located at the Rural Services site.
